- Be a good role model

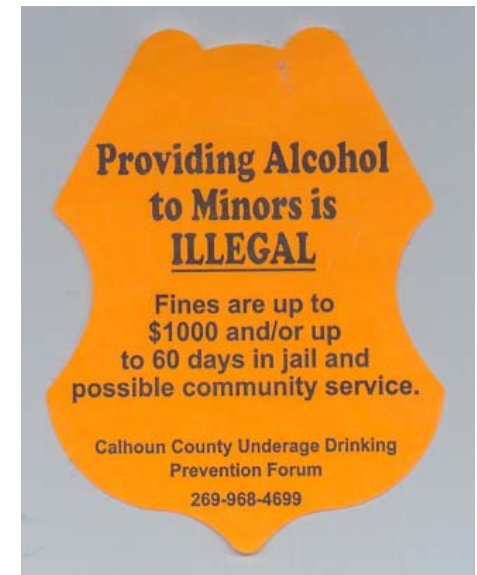
Limit Access

- Provide alcohol free alternative activities
- Don't assume teens drink
- Support law enforcement efforts
