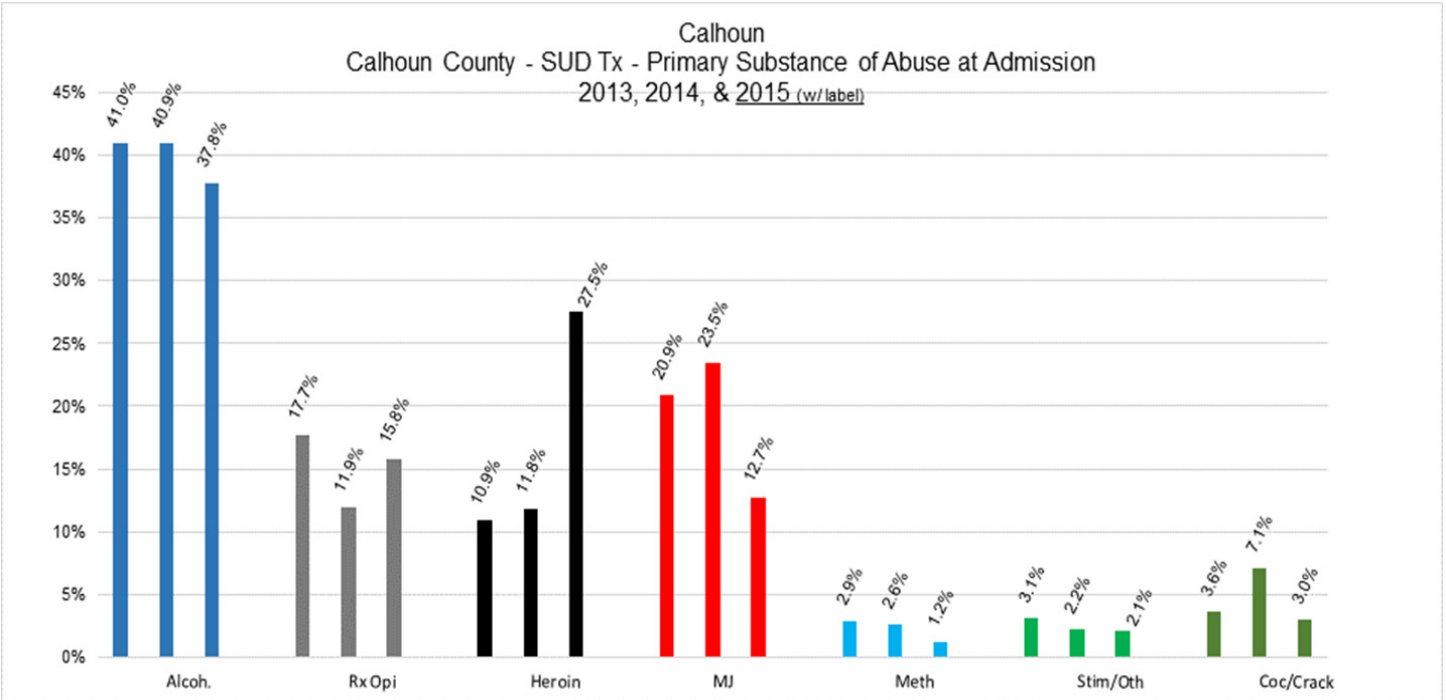


# TREATMENT

In 2015, there was a high spike in individuals seeking treatment for heroin addiction. With the growing heroin problem in Calhoun County, this is not surprising. As in previous years, alcohol remains the top substance individuals seek treatment for. Actual need for substance abuse and addiction treatment services is difficult to determine as many individuals do not seek treatment due to lack of insurance, lack of financial resources, fear of losing custody of their children and social stigmas associated with seeking treatment.
